


This allows for efficient generation of *burnt-in* subtitles in the required output file formats, while leaving the archive source file clean.

How it works:

The new Screen Filter is selected in FlipFactory. Subtitle processors are then configured to generate the desired subtitle style results, whereby subtitles are automatically applied to the media during the transcode process to deliver the required output.
