



## Flip4Mac WMV 2.3 Release Notes

Flip4Mac WMV is a collection of QuickTime™ components that allow you to play, import and export Windows Media® files. Flip4Mac WMV can be used with most QuickTime applications including QuickTime Player, and Final Cut Pro.

### ***System Requirements***

Flip4Mac WMV components are compatible with Intel and PowerPC (G4+) Mac OS X versions 10.4 or later (including Snow Leopard); QuickTime 7.0 & QuickTime X (7.1.6 or higher recommended).

### ***Upgrade***

After installing Flip4Mac WMV you can play Windows Media files in QuickTime Player and view Windows Media content on the Internet using Safari and other web browsers.

By upgrading Flip4Mac WMV you will be able to import Windows Media files for editing or create Windows Media files for distribution. These features are available in trial mode until you're ready to purchase an upgrade.

You can purchase an upgrade at the Telestream Store or directly from the software by selecting Flip4Mac WMV in the System Preferences application.

### ***Web Browser Support***

Flip4Mac WMV includes an Internet plug-in that plays Windows Media streams within Safari and other web browsers.

While the Flip4Mac WMV plug-in provides superior playback performance, it is unable to play content that has been protected using Windows Digital Rights Management (DRM).

### ***Changes in this Release***

- Added support for Apple's Mac OS X Snow Leopard.
  - While support for the latest OS is good news, we'd like you to be aware of some changes in Snow Leopard that affect Flip4Mac WMV (see [Flip4Mac WMV FAQs](#) for more details):
    - QuickTime Player X has removed export functionality to all formats other than standard Apple formats, including WMV. If you need this functionality, Apple continues to provide QuickTime Player 7.
    - In Safari 4, Flip4Mac WMV runs with limited functionality.
    - Safari 4 now runs in 64-bit mode by default, which causes Flip4Mac WMV to run with limited functionality. However, you have the option to run Safari in 32-bit mode.
- Local files now import in the background by default so that your movie is available for viewing almost immediately. If you prefer the previous behavior, this can be changed on

a per-application basis in Flip4Mac WMV by going to System Preferences > Flip4Mac WMV > Player and clicking the Advanced button.

- The installer also includes a browser plug-in for Microsoft® Silverlight™, which allows you to play Smooth Streaming video content. This is installed by default. To disable its installation, click the Customize button on the Installation Type pane and uncheck the Microsoft Silverlight Plug-in option.

### ***Fixes in this Release:***

- Fixed bug that prevented ASX streams from playing in Firefox 3.
- Other miscellaneous bug fixes and improvements.

### ***Known Web Browser Issue***

- When using Safari 4 and Firefox 3.5, your browser experience is going to be different (see [Flip4Mac WMV FAQs](#) for more details)
