



ScreenFlow Version 1.5.1 Release Notes

NOTE: This release includes critical bug fixes.

Enhancements

- Titling and text support. ScreenFlow 1.5.1 brings support for adding text objects directly to the timeline, with multiple fonts and styles for creating beautiful titles.
- Customizable mouse pointers. ScreenFlow 1.5.1 lets you replace the recorded system mouse pointer with any image you like, including simulation of touch screen and finger pointer, to make beautiful iPhone screencasts. With a built-in circle cursor option and new 'Invert' mouse click effect, it's now even easier for iPhone developers to create great screencasts.
- Audio Effects. ScreenFlow 1.5.1 builds in over ten audio effects you can apply to recording, making it easy to add depth and warmth to your narration.
- Mono microphones mixed to stereo. Professional microphones that record to a single channel can now have their audio mixed into stereo automatically.
- Integration with Telestream's <u>Flip4Mac WMV</u>. WMV Components (starting at \$49) provide integrated Windows Media Video format export.

Notable Changes

Documents saved in ScreenFlow 1.5.1 cannot be opened in earlier versions of the application.

Software Download

System Requirements

Mac OS X Leopard 10.5 or later G4 or Intel based CPU required. Core 2 Duo recommended A <u>Quartz Extreme</u> capable graphics card A supported programmable GPU required for certain effects & functionality

Bug Fixes

- Fixed a crash related to importing QuickTime content after upgrading to QuickTime 7.6.
- Fixed an application crash related to exporting to AppleTV / iPod / iPhone after upgrading to QuickTime 7.6.
- Fixed an issue preventing export of audio only QuickTime content.
- Resolved a problem importing PAL exported content into Final Cut Pro.
- Fixed a bug pinning the start time of still image clips in the timeline.
- ScreenFlow will display a warning if fast-user switching is activated. Due to operating system security, other sessions cannot be recorded.
- Resolved a rare condition where activation of the application wouldn't be retained across restarts.
- ScreenFlow will now prevent additional screen recordings starting when one is already in progress.
