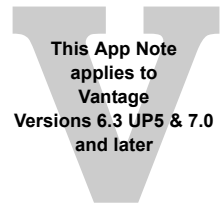

Note: This guide is written for video professionals who are familiar with using Vantage. To implement applications in Vantage, you should know how to create workflows and submit jobs. If you aren't familiar with Vantage, we suggest that you review the *Vantage User's Guide* and *Vantage Domain Management Guide* as needed.

Synopsis

Emotion Systems focuses on addressing audio signal processing requirements in File-Based workflows. To do this, Emotion Systems has created eENGINE, a flexible and scalable audio server, either used for achieving medium to high levels of processing in an automated environment, or for providing flexibility in broadcast and playout environments.

The Emotion eENGINE has scalable modules for Dolby E encoding, Dolby E decoding, Dolby E guard band correction, track extraction, track mapping, muting, adding audio tracks, adding a commentary track for the visually impaired and for compliance with loudness specifications that are now mandated in many regions of the world.

Emotion Features

Emotion the following audio processing features

- Loudness Compliance
- Channel Mapping and Muting
- Dolby E Decoding/Encoding
- Dolby E Guardband Correction
- Stereo to 5.1 Upmix
- 5.1 to stereo downmix, and stereo to mono downmix
- Audio extraction to WAV
- Audio insertion from AIFF/WAV
- Advanced analysis and XML reporting
- Audio Descriptor insertion using a control track
- MXF - Change the number of audio channels

When multiple functions are purchased, they can be used individually, or can be ganged into complex sequences for automatic operation.

Vantage and Emotion

Emotion Connector is an optional, licensed feature in Vantage. This app note describes how to integrate Emotion's eENGINE service into Vantage, so that you can automate Emotion audio processes by adding Emotion connector actions directly into your workflows.

Vantage Emotion Action Inputs

- Media - Source File(s)
 - One or more source files.
- Input File - Descriptor Input File(s)
 - One or more Input files.

Vantage Emotion Action Outputs

- Output Media File(s) - The result of Emotion audio processing
 - One or more output files media files
- PDF Report - An Emotion Report in PDF format

Note: The number of Input and Output files is determined by the Emotion workflow template chosen.

Note: By default, the Vantage Emotion action will fail with an explicit error message upon file collision. This behavior can be changed by the eENGINE-Configurator application under *Configure -> Destination Copy Options* in order to overwrite output files upon collision.

Note: Some of the Emotion workflows do not output a media file by default, such as the eXAMINE workflow. This can cause the media output nickname of the Vantage Emotion action to reference a file that does not exist. One solution is to change the setting to *Copy source file*, which is located in *eENGINE-Configurator -> Configure -> Destination File Option*. Enabling *Copy source file* will cause the Vantage Emotion action output of the eXAMINE workflow to be the source file provided to the action.

Emotion and Vantage Requirements

Software

The following versions are required:

This release requires Vantage 6.3 UP5 or 7.0 to be installed on the Emotion Systems server. For Vantage 6.3 UP5 only, in order to install Vantage on the Emotion server, a Vantage service, such as the SDK service, is required.

Only the Vantage 6.3 UP5 Emotion Service Update or the Vantage 7.0 Emotion Service should be installed on the Emotion Systems server.

If you do not currently have Vantage 6.3 UP5 or 7.0 or later, download the latest version from www.telestream.net and obtain a license that includes the Vantage Emotion Connector from Telestream.

- Vantage 6.3 UP5 or 7.0 or later:
 - Vantage Emotion Connector Installer patch (for Vantage 6.3 systems)
 - Vantage Emotion Connector license
- Emotion eENGINE v6.3.3

Licensing

Both the Vantage Emotion Connector and Emotion Systems software require separate licensing.

The Vantage Emotion Connector is licensed through the Vantage option V-EMOTION-CONN.

Emotion Systems software must be purchased and licensed directly from Emotion Systems or an authorized Emotion Systems reseller. Each instance can process up to 4 actions at a time by default.

Note: Emotion typically licenses servers for running between 1 to 8 jobs at a time. The number of concurrent Emotion jobs is determined by the number of Emotion eSP (Signal Process). Ideally the Vantage session limit for the Emotion service should be configured to match the number of eSP's enabled for the Emotion server. Alternatively, the session limit for the Vantage Emotion service should be less than or equal to the number of eSP's enabled.

Emotion Integration with Vantage

This option should be considered by any Vantage customer who requires automated audio processing.

The Vantage Emotion Connector service works in tandem with Emotion eENGINE audio software to provide an effective method of automating complex audio processing.

If you do not currently have Vantage 6.3 UP5 or later, download it from www.telestream.net and obtain a license from Telestream that includes the Vantage Emotion Connector.

If you already have Vantage 6.3 UP5 or 7.0 or later, obtain a license from Telestream that includes the Vantage Emotion Connector.

Note: Telestream does not resell Emotion Systems software. Telestream sells a connector (V-EMOTION-CONN) for integrating Emotion Systems. This connector is based on Emotion Systems version 6.3.3 software, and is not backward compatible with previous Emotion Systems 6.x versions. The Emotion Systems software and instructions for installing it can be obtained from Emotion Systems or an authorized Emotion Systems reseller/dealer.

Installation

Follow these installation instructions to install the Vantage Emotion Connector and Vantage on your Emotion eENGINE server running eENGINE 6.3.3:

1. Obtain the Vantage and Vantage Emotion Connector installers from the Telestream Vantage download web site.
2. Install Vantage's Emotion Connector service on your eENGINE servers.
 - a. **Vantage v6.3:** If your system is running Vantage 6.3 you will install the Vantage SDK Service from the Vantage 6.3 installer and the Vantage Emotion Connector through a separate Vantage Emotion Connector patch installer that is available on the Vantage download page.
 - First, install the Vantage SDK Service by running the full Vantage 6.3 installer and selecting Custom Install option. Deselect all Vantage Applications and Services except the SDK Service. Complete the installation by following the on-screen instructions.
 - Next, obtain the Emotion patch installer by logging onto the Vantage download site at <http://dynamic.telestream.net/downloads/download-vantage.asp?prodid=vantage>.
 - From the Previous Version's drop down menu, select Vantage 6.3.
 - On the Vantage 6.3 download page, navigate to the Updates tab and from the Vantage Partner Integration Updates section download the Emotion patch installer.
 - To install the Vantage Emotion Connector, run the patch installer on your Emotion eENGINE server(s) following the on screen instructions.
 - b. **Upgrade Vantage 6.3 UP5 to 7.0 or later:** To upgrade the Vantage Emotion Service from the Vantage 6.3 UP5 Update to 7.0, you should first uninstall the Vantage 6.3 Emotion Service Update and UP5. Then run the Vantage 7.0 setup to install the Vantage Emotion Service as explained in step C.
 - c. **Vantage v7.0 or later:** If your system is running Vantage 7.0, you will install the Vantage Emotion Connector Service on your Emotion eENGINE servers directly through the Vantage 7.0 installer's *Custom Install* option. Run the installer and from the *Custom Install* menu, deselect all Vantage items except the Emotion

Service. Click *OK* and complete the installation by following the on-screen instructions.

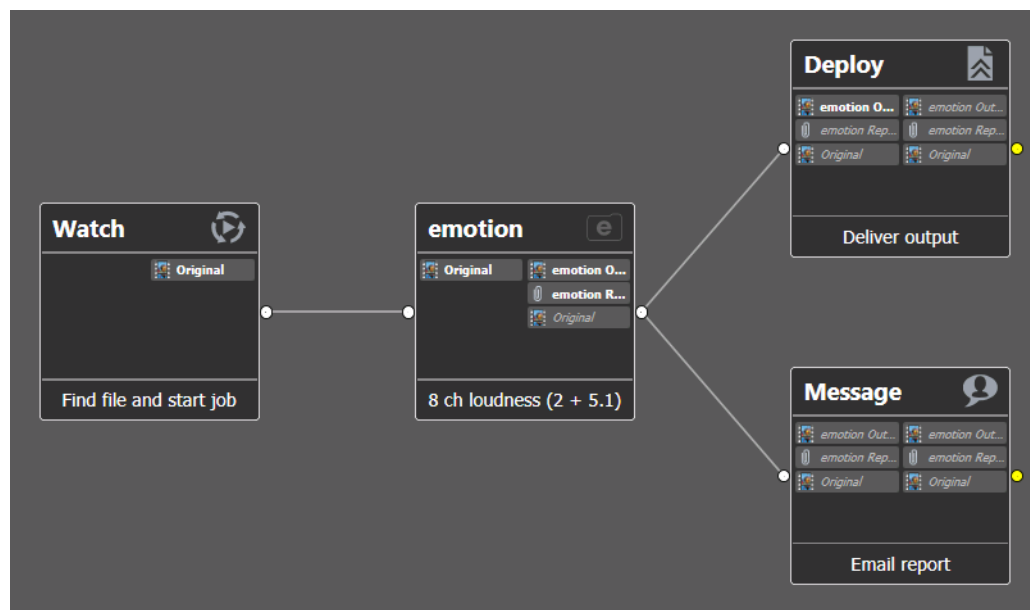
3. From the Vantage Management Console add the Metrics and Emotion services running on your eENGINE server(s) to your Vantage domain by following the instructions found in the Vantage Domain Management Guide. This adds the Vantage Metrics and Emotion Services (running on your Emotion eENGINE server) to your Vantage Domain.
4. Apply any Vantage licensing if necessary.

Important Note: Jobs submitted directly to a third party application, or from other systems not within Vantage management control can cause undesirable workflow delays due to lack of available third party resources or available licenses. Best practice when using Vantage with third party application services is to limit the use of the third party application service to Vantage alone. This will prevent processing delays caused by resources being consumed by processes not under Vantage management control.

Example Emotion Workflow

The following workflow example includes an *Emotion* action and operates as follows:

1. This workflow begins with a Watch action, configured to monitor a target location for incoming media.
2. When the job starts, the Emotion action is executed. The media file is passed to Emotion eENGINE software to perform the selected audio processing.
3. When eENGINE software has completed the specified processes, it creates an output media file and a PDF report.

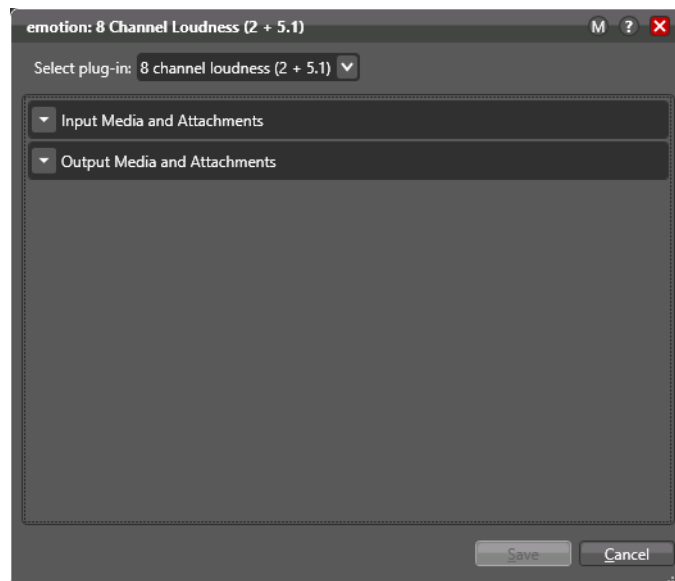


4. A Deploy action is used to deliver the Emotion media output to its final destination.
5. At the end of the workflow, a Message action emails the Emotion PRD report to a recipient.

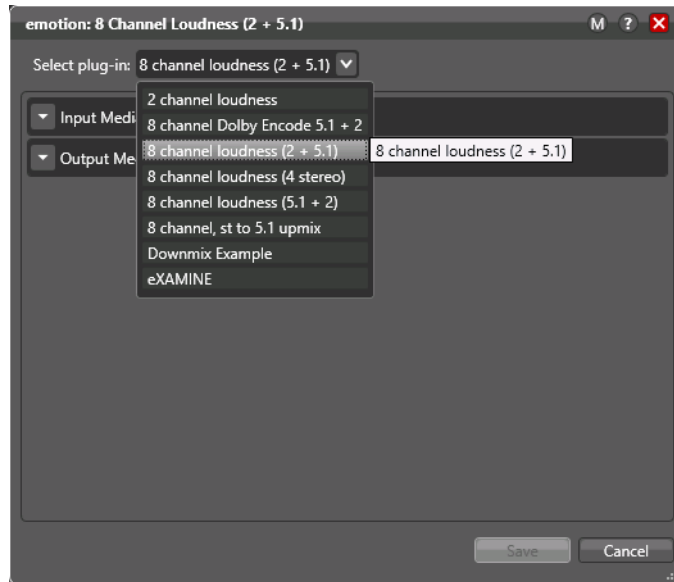
Configuring Emotion Actions

Follow these steps to configure the Emotion action:

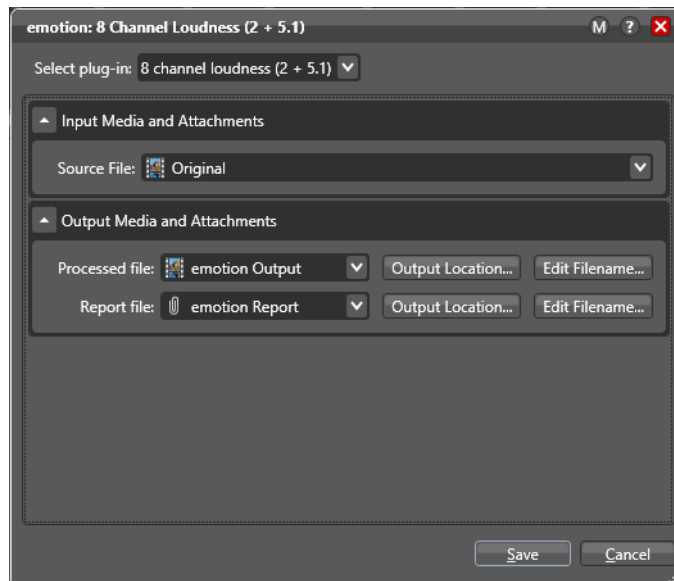
1. Create a workflow similar to the one shown in previous topic.
2. Click and drag the Watch and Emotion actions into the workflow and connect them.
3. Click the "i" in the upper left corner of the action to open the Inspector.



4. Select the Emotion audio processing template from the plug-in drop down.



5. Fill in the required fields, and click Next to proceed to the next panel.



6. Click *Save* to save the configured action.
7. Activate the workflow, and submit a file to test for successful workflow operation.
8. Connect a Deploy action to the Emotion action output. Configure the Deploy action to deliver the Emotion media output to a final destination.
9. Additionally connect a Message action to the Emotion action output. Provide a target email address and enable the "Attach available attachments" check-box. Set the subject field to the Job Name token. Note that SMTP settings must be configured in the Vantage Management Console under Settings & Options.

Support

Telestream support staff will be the first line for supporting the Vantage Emotion Connector's action controls and interaction with Emotion eENGINE software. If our support staff determines that the support needs are directly associated with the Emotion connector agent or Emotion eENGINE software, Telestream will connect the customer to Emotion support directly.
