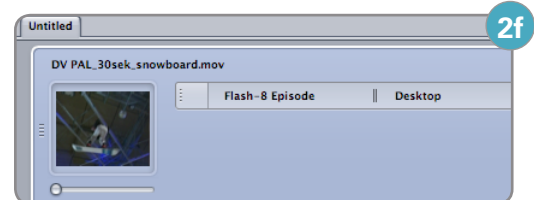
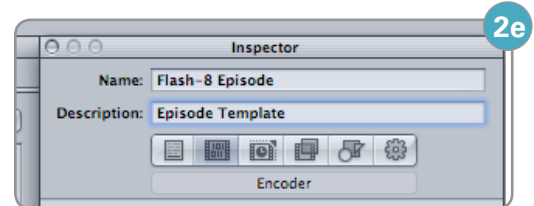
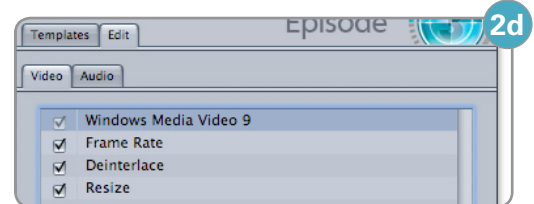
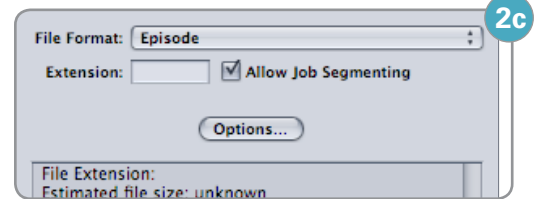
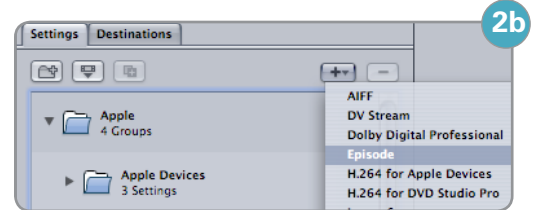


# Getting Started With Episode Plug-In for Compressor

## 1 Install

- Install Episode® Encoder or Episode Encoder Pro by dragging the application to your Applications folder.
- Install the Compressor plug-in by double-clicking "Episode Plug-in for Compressor.pkg". Note, you need to have Compressor 3 or later installed before installing the plugin.
- Read the installation information and the License Agreement and click continue.
- Choose a destination where you wish to install the plugin. You have to choose the same location as Compressor.
- Follow the instructions to complete the installation.



## 2 Encode using Episode Encoder

- Start Compressor.
- To use Episode Encoder formats from within Compressor, click the "+" button in the Settings window and select Episode Encoder.
- Go to the inspector and click the Options button. Browse to the Episode Encoder setting you wish to use for your encoding.
- Flash and Windows Media settings can be edited directly in Compressor; just select a setting and click the Edit tab.\*
- Fill in a name and description for your setting, then save. Your setting is now available in the settings window in your Custom folder.
- To encode, drag a file into the batch window, then drop your Episode Encoder setting onto the file and click the Submit button. Note, if your setting contains a watermark, a bumper, or a trailer, it will not work from within Compressor.

### \* Edit or create new settings

How to edit a setting (other than Flash or Windows Media), or create your own customized setting in Episode Encoder:

- Open Episode Encoder or Episode Encoder Pro
- Use the browser on the left to find the setting that you wish to edit or create a new setting by clicking the "New Setting" button
- Double-click the setting and make your adjustments in the Settings Editor
