

1. In Final Cut Pro 5, choose File > Export > Using Compressor...

3. In Compressor, choose Settings > New Default Setting > QuickTime Export Components

2. Compressor displays a new Batch window... select your source media

4. In the Inspector, change Encoder Type to Windows Media

9. Click Submit to encode your media in WMV9 format

5. Click Options to display WMV Export's Windows Media Export Settings

7. Click Save As to save settings

8. Name your settings and click OK

6. Adjust Video and Audio, then click OK to update Windows Media Export settings and return to Compressor and save your settings
