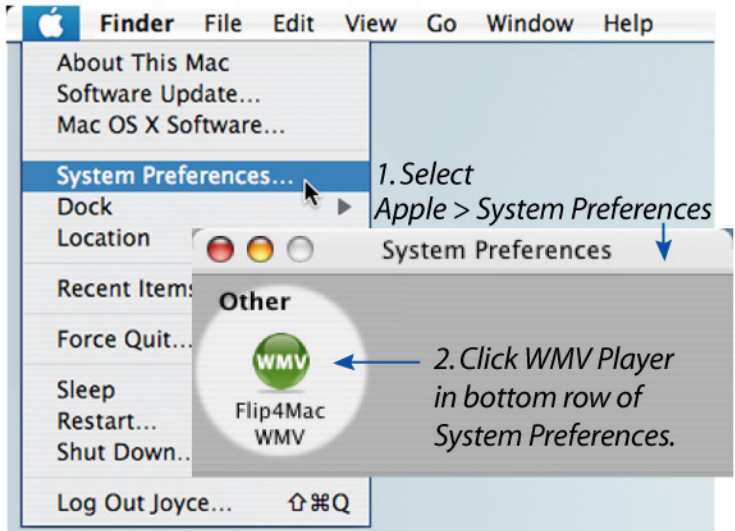

Purchasing & Registering Flip4Mac WMV...



1. Select Apple > System Preferences

2. Click WMV Player in bottom row of System Preferences.

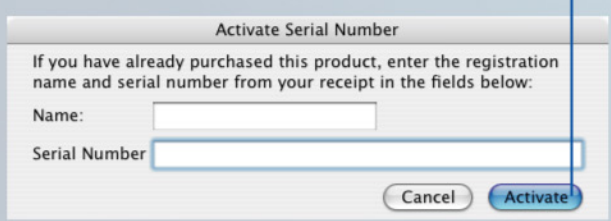
(If WMV Player doesn't display in System Preferences, go to www.flip4mac.com to download and install Flip4Mac WMV.)

3. Click Enter Serial Number if you purchased from the Web site & received your confirmation email.



4. Click Purchase to buy directly in Flip4Mac WMV.

5. Enter name & serial number exactly as shown in the order confirmation email (you can cut and paste). The information is case-sensitive, and only zeroes are used in the serial number.



6. When information is entered correctly, click Activate to register Flip4Mac WMV.

If your Macintosh is not connected to the Internet, contact support@flip4mac.com for assistance in activating your license.

Playing Windows Media files in QuickTime Player...



1. Select File > Open File

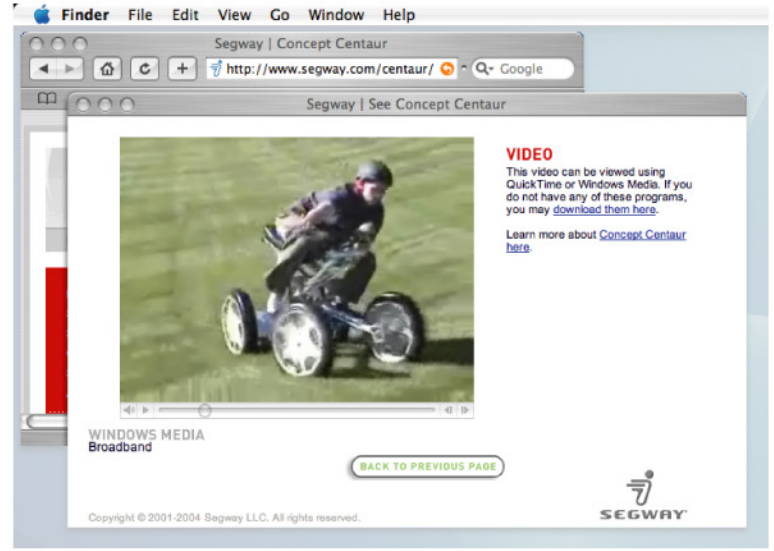
2. Select a Windows Media file to play.

3. Play directly in QuickTime Player.

Playing Windows Media files in Safari...



Click Windows Media links in Web pages to play Windows Media directly in your Web browser.

In QuickTime Pro...

1. Choose File > Export

2. Select "Movie to Windows media" from Export

3. Select Preset Encoder Settings from Use

4. Click Options to display Windows Media Export Settings

5. Click Save to encode your media

In Final Cut Pro HD & Final Cut Express HD...

1. Choose File > Export > Using QuickTime Conversion

2. Select "Movie to Windows media" from Format

3. Select Preset Encoder Settings from Use

4. Click Options to display Windows Media Export Settings

5. Click Save to encode your media

In iMovie or iMovie HD...

1. Choose File > Share

2. Select QuickTime

3. Select Expert Settings

4. Click Share

5. Select "Movie to Windows media" from Export

6. Select Preset Encoder Settings from Use

7. Click Options to display Windows Media Export Settings

8. Click Save to encode your media

Windows Media Export Settings...
 From each application, click Options to review and change video and audio encoder settings, then click OK to return.

Export using: WMV 9 Standard
 Coding Method: One pass, variable bit rate (VBR)
 Quality = 90
 Bit rate: 185 kbits/second
 Peak bit rate: 370 kbits/second
 Frame Format: Size: Current, Rate: 29.97 frames/second

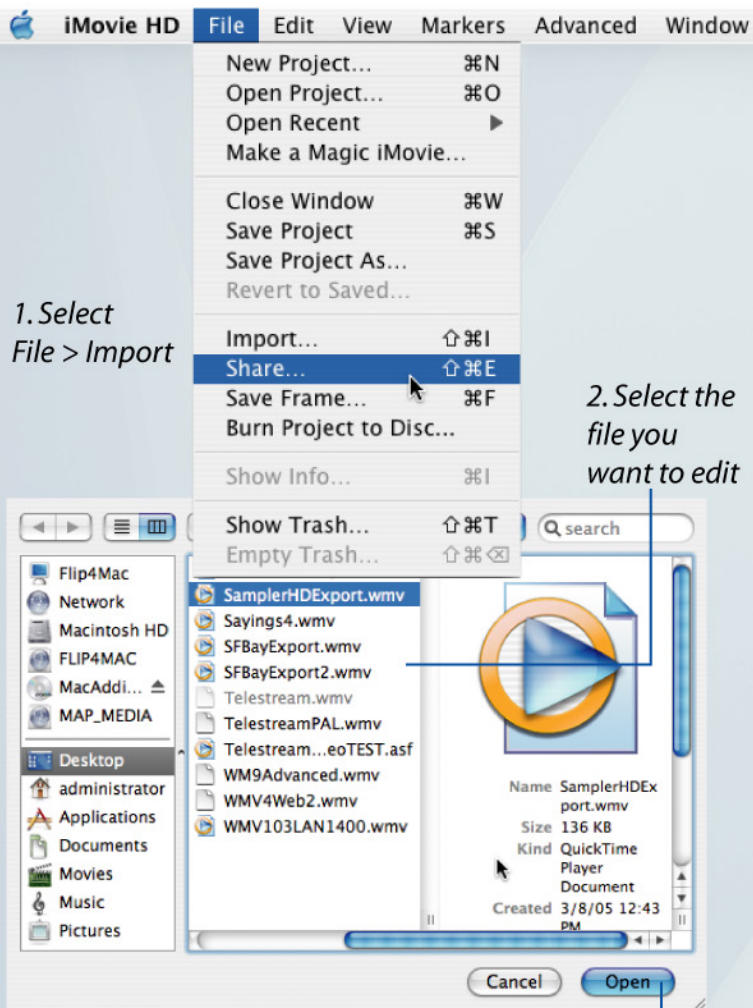
Export using: WMA 9 Standard
 Coding Method: One pass, constant bit rate (CBR)
 64 kbps, 44.1 khz, Stereo

2. Click OK to update Windows Media Export settings and return to your application and encode your media

Importing Windows Media for Edit / Conversion...

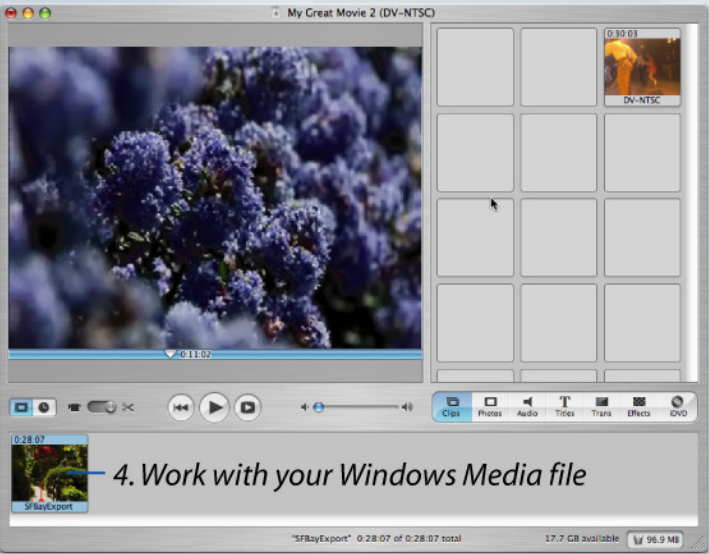
Setting WMV Player Preferences...



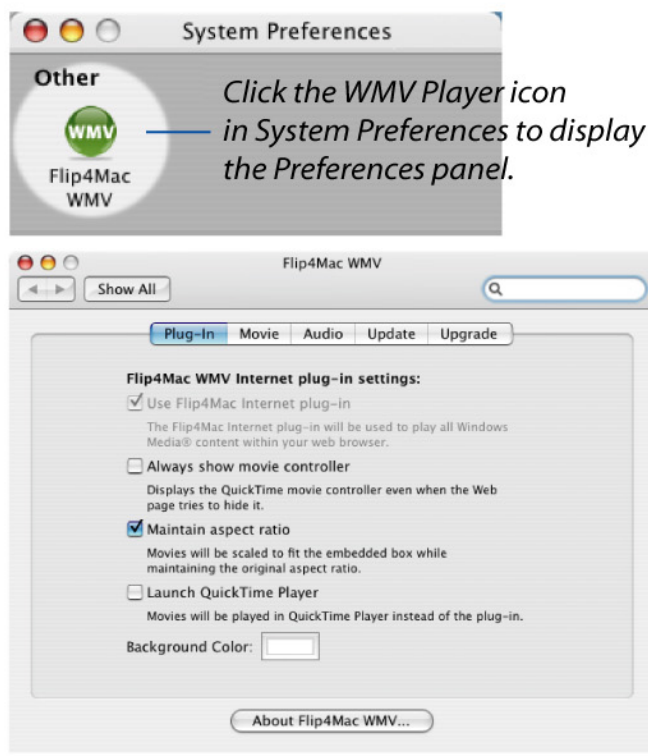
1. Select File > Import

2. Select the file you want to edit

3. Click Open to import the Windows Media file



4. Work with your Windows Media file

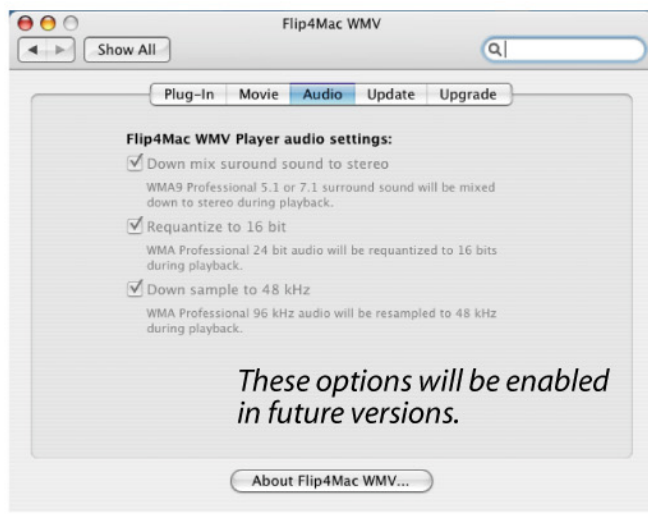


Click the WMV Player icon in System Preferences to display the Preferences panel.



Flip4Mac WMV Player movie settings:

- Play movies automatically
- Import local files immediately
- Import streaming movies



Flip4Mac WMV Player audio settings:

- Down mix surround sound to stereo
- Requantize to 16 bit
- Down sample to 48 kHz

These options will be enabled in future versions.

Importing Windows Media files is similar in Final Cut Pro and Final Cut Express.
