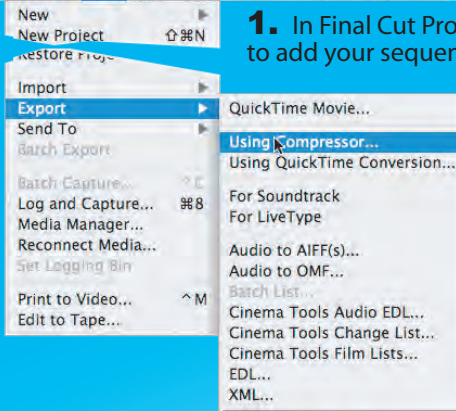
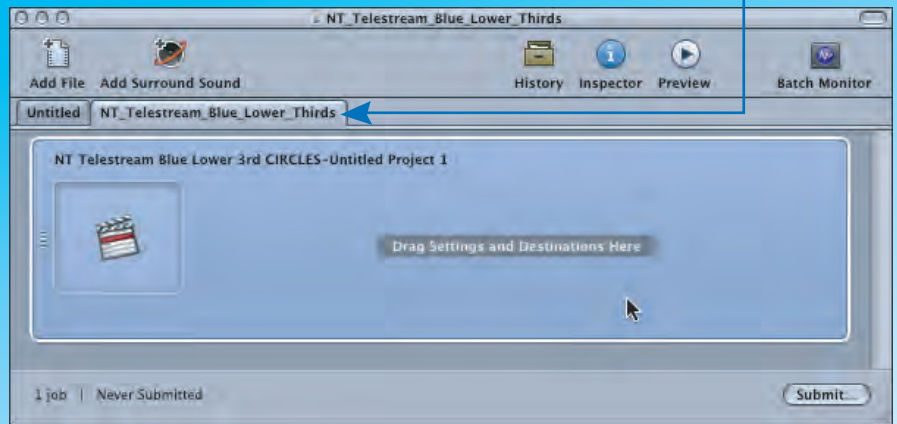


Final Cut Pro File Edit View Mark Modify Sequence

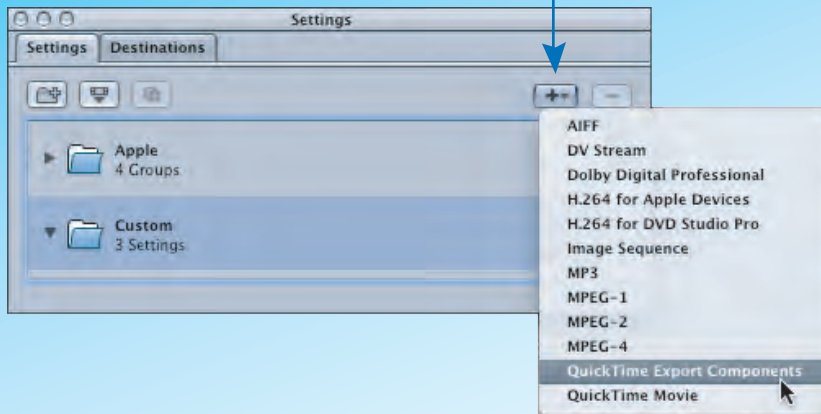
1. In Final Cut Pro, select a sequence, then choose File > Export > Using Compressor to add your sequence to the Compressor Job Batch



2. Compressor displays the Job Batch window... select the Job tab for your source media sequence

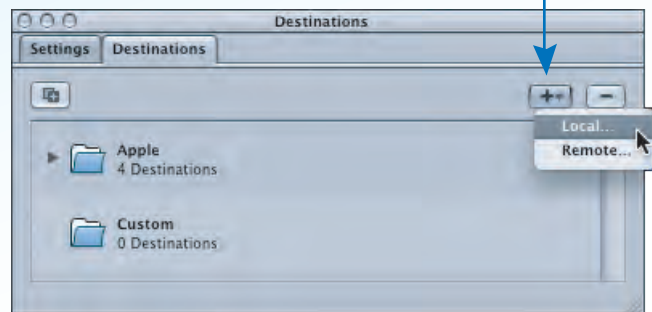


3. In Compressor's Settings pane... click on the Settings tab, click + and select QuickTime Export Components

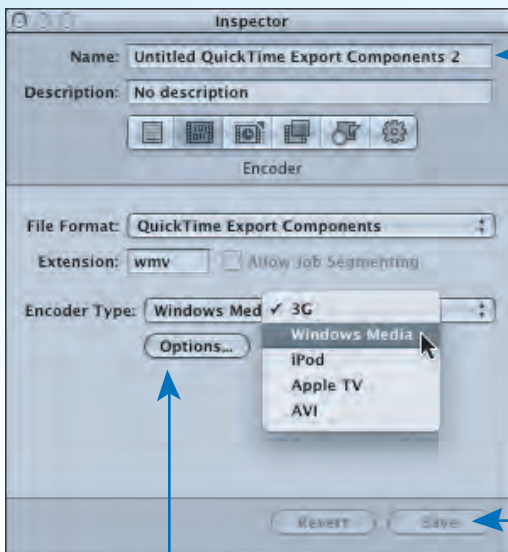

5. In the Inspector pane... change Encoder Type to Windows Media and provide a name for this setting

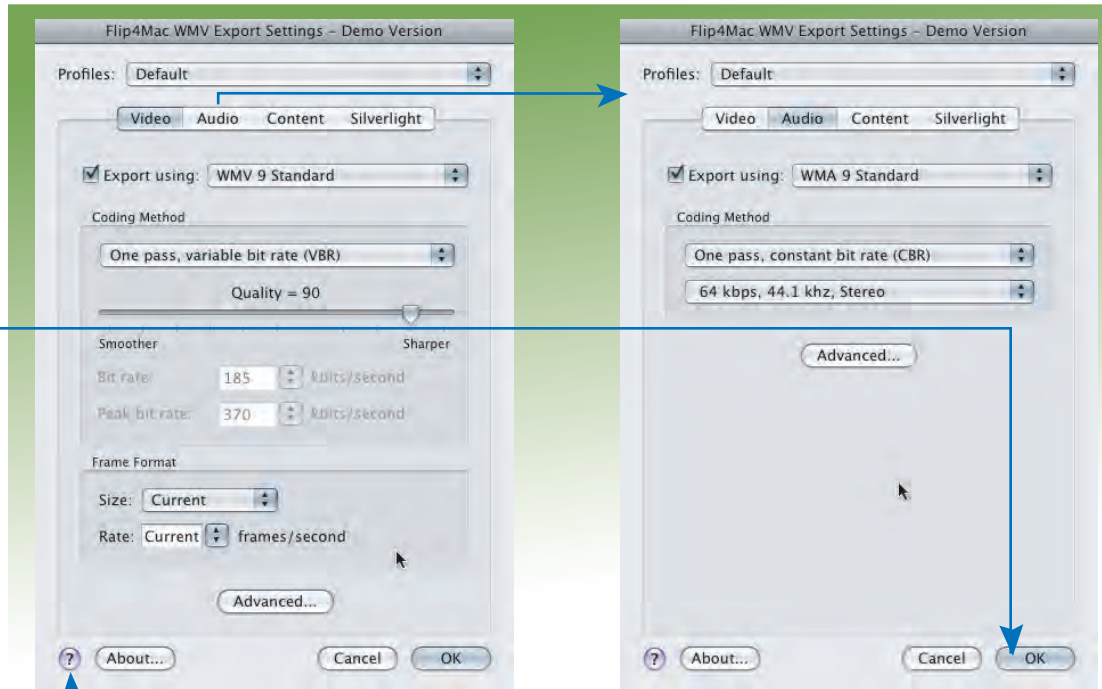


6. Click Options to display WMV Export's Windows Media Settings (next page)

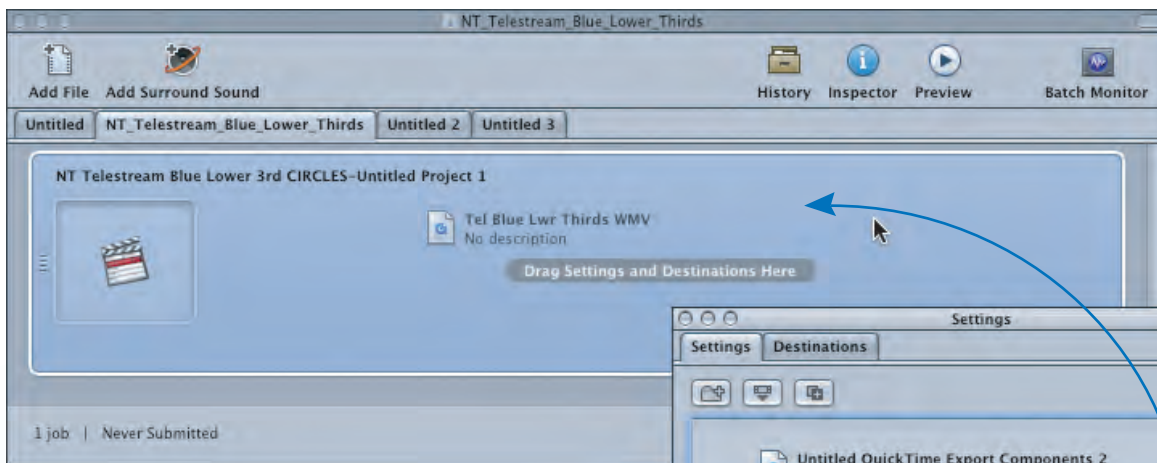


WMV Export's Windows Media Settings...

7. Adjust Video and Audio, then click OK to update Windows Media Export settings

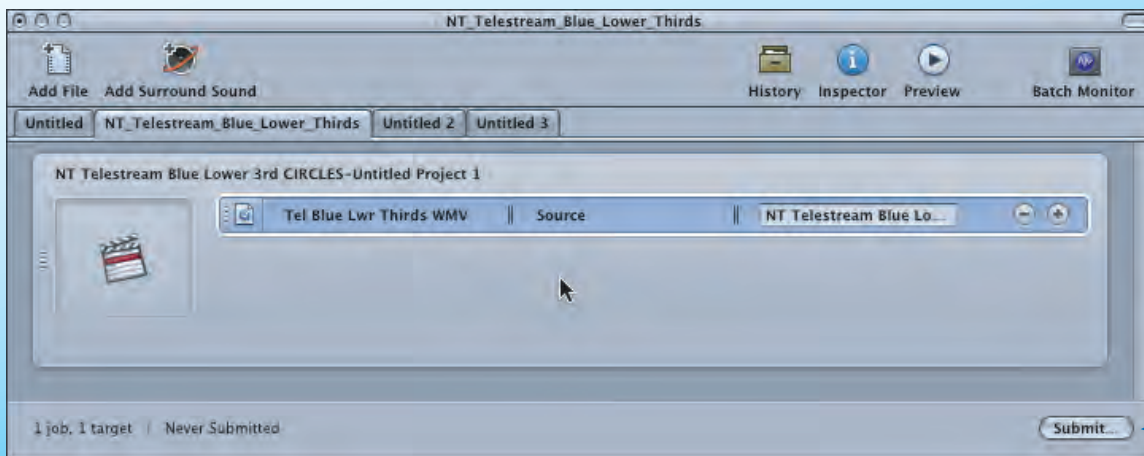
