

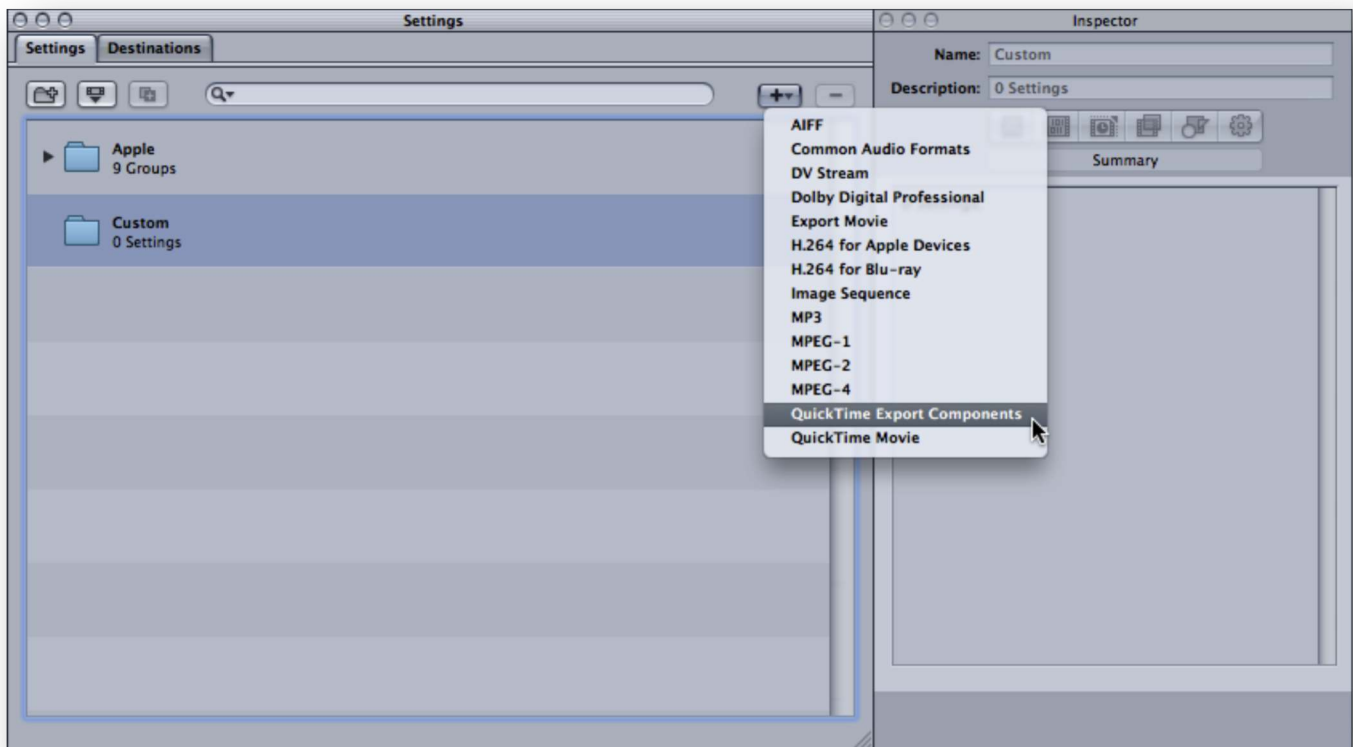


Flip4Mac WMV: How to export WMV from Final Cut Pro X

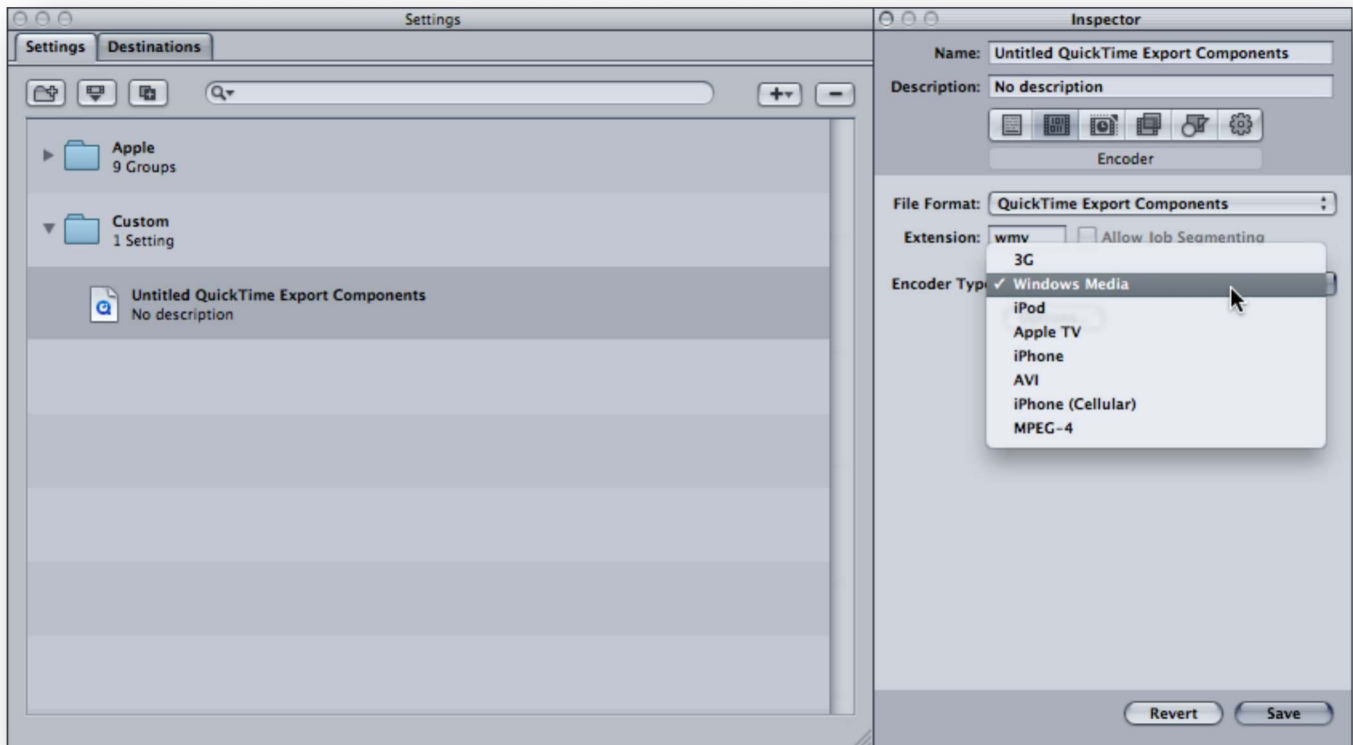
Final Cut Pro X introduced a new *Share* menu for video file exports. Classic QuickTime export options are not available anymore. Customers require the additional Compressor 4 transcoding application to get more export options available in the Share menu.

Compressor 4 supports all Flip4Mac upgrade levels. Customers need to create WMV export presets in Compressor with Flip4Mac WMV.

1. Click on the **+** button on the upper right in Compressor's *Settings* window to add new export settings to Compressor.
2. In the drop-down menu select *QuickTime Export Components*.



3. You can modify your preset in the *Inspector* window. Make sure that **File Format** is set to *QuickTime Export Components*. In the **Encoder Type** drop-down menu select *Windows Media*.

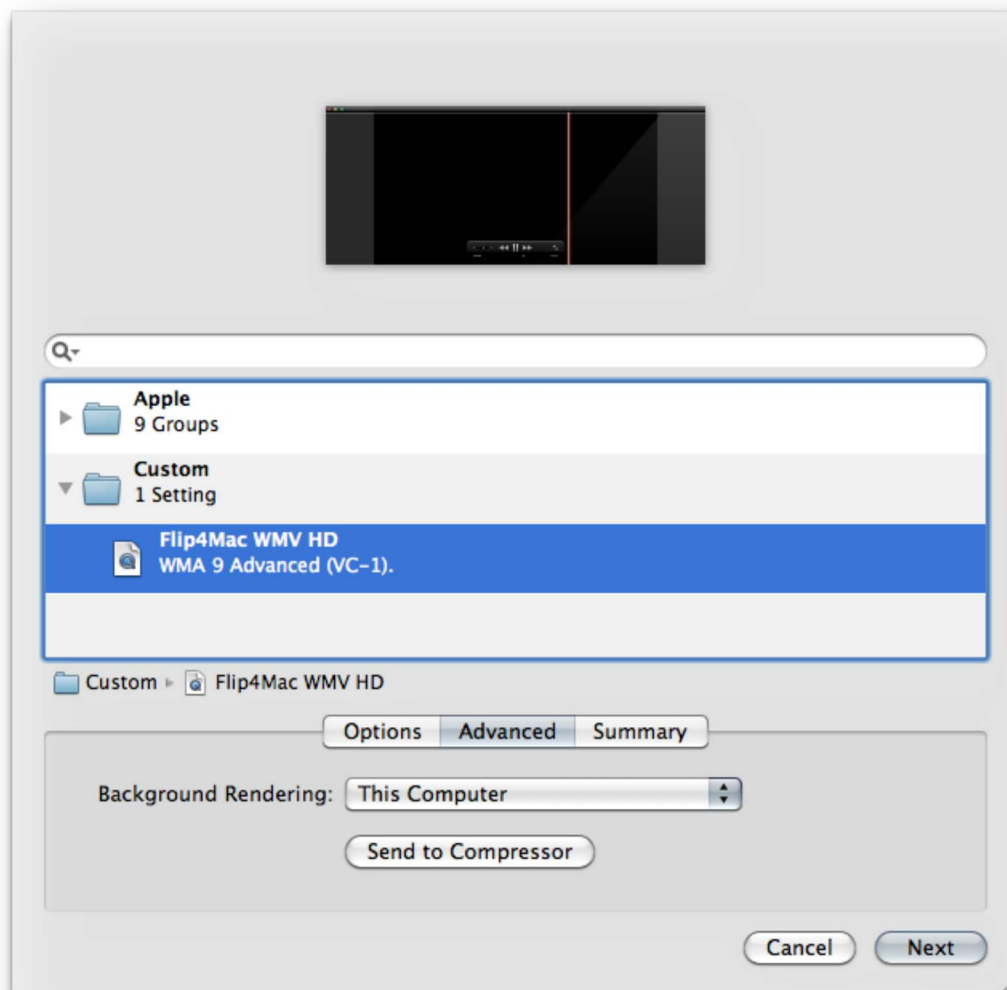


4. The **Options** button will open the *Flip4Mac WMV Export Settings* window that allows you to modify your WMV and WMA settings. This is the same window used when exporting from QuickTime 7 Player and other applications.
5. Add a fitting **Name** and **Description** for your preset.

Please create a separate preset in Compressor for each WMV setting that you want to access from Final Cut Pro X.

You can export Final Cut Pro X events via the **Share** menu.

1. To access your WMV export preset, select *Export Using Compressor Settings...* in the **Share** menu.



2. Select your WMV export preset from the *Custom* folder.
3. Check the **Advanced** tab for *Background Rendering* settings.
4. When you are done click the **Next** button to start the WMV export.
