Flip4Mac Infinity Component

Using Telestream's Flip4Mac Infinity Component, Final Cut Pro users benefit from a file-based media workflow. With Flip4Mac Infinity, you can ingest MXF files from Grass Valley Group's REV PRO drives with media from Infinity Digital Media Camcorders and Recorders, or from your Macintosh and LAN or SAN servers, directly into Apple's Final Cut Pro editing software.

Flip4Mac Infinity Component makes it easy to...

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- Connect and browse files directly on REV PRO drives
- Import MXF files from REV PRO drives created by Infinity Camcorders and Recorders
- Ingest DV and HDV media as QuickTime files into Final Cut Pro
- Redefine your workflow and increase your productivity.

Flip4Mac Infinity Component enables Macintosh users to browse and import MXF media for quick and easy access – without going to baseband video. This means a faster, all-digital, file-based workflow that provides greater efficiency and productivity for you.

Downloading & Installing

- Flip4Mac Infinity Component is distributed as an Internet-enabled disk image. To download and install Flip4Mac Infinity, follow these steps:
 - 1. Visit www.flip4mac.com and download Flip4Mac Infinity to your Macintosh.
 - 2. When the disk image downloads, the installer runs automatically.

If you have a previous version of Flip4Mac Infinity, this version automatically updates your previous version.

Note: If your Macintosh isn't connected to the Internet, download the Flip4Mac Infinity disk image file to another computer (Macintosh or Windows). Then, move the disk image file (copy over LAN or burn a CD) to your Macintosh and install it.

Trying Out Flip4Mac Infinity

After installation, Flip4Mac Infinity operates in trial mode until you purchase a license. You're welcome to try out Flip4Mac Infinity for as long as you like.

In trial mode, Flip4Mac Infinity imports or exports the first half of an MXF file, up to 30 seconds in length.

To import entire MXF files or export entire IMX files, you need to purchase and activate a serial number using one of the options described below.

Purchase Options

To purchase a license for Flip4Mac Infinity, choose from these secure purchase options:

Option 1 - Purchase Directly in System Preferences (Page 3). If you're using Flip4Mac Infinity in trial mode and your Macintosh is connected to the Internet, you can purchase a serial number directly from System Preferences. When the purchase is complete your serial number is automatically activated.

Option 2 - Purchase from Flip4Mac Web Site (Page 4). Choose this option if:

- You haven't installed a trial version of Flip4Mac Infinity yet,
- You prefer to use a Web site to purchase your license,
- Or, your Macintosh isn't connected to the Internet.


Purchase Directly in System Preferences

If your Macintosh is connected to the Internet and you've installed Flip4Mac Infinity, you can purchase a license and activate it directly in System Preferences.

Follow these steps:

1. Open Applications > System Preferences.

2. Click the Flip4Mac Infinity icon (in the Other row at the bottom) to display the Flip4Mac Infinity panel. Figure 4. Flip4Mac Infinity Preferences panel allows you to purchase or update your software.

3. If this panel is locked, click the lock and provide credentials to unlock it.

- 4. Click Purchase License to display the secure Flip4Mac online store.
- 5. Use the shopping cart to purchase a license for your software.

When the purchase is complete, the serial number is automatically installed and your software is activated. You should print the receipt before closing the shopping cart.

When your copy of Flip4Mac Infinity is licensed, you can import and export without file size or duration limits.

You'll also receive an order confirmation receipt via email, which also contains the serial number. Save the receipt in case you ever need to re-install the software.

Purchase from the Flip4Mac Web Site


To purchase from the Flip4Mac site, follow these steps:

1. Go to www.flip4mac.com and click Buy to display the Flip4Mac secure online store. Follow the instructions to navigate to the shopping cart and purchase a license for your software. You should print the receipt before closing the shopping cart.

When the purchase is complete, you will receive an order confirmation receipt via email, which contains the serial number. When the email arrives (usually momentarily), continue.

2. Open Applications > System Preferences and click the Flip4Mac Infinity icon (in the *Other* row at the bottom) to display the Flip4Mac Infinity preferences panel.

3. Click the Flip4Mac Infinity icon (in Other row at bottom) to display the Flip4Mac Infinity License panel. Figure 6. Click Enter Serial Number to display the Activate Serial Number dialog.

- 4. If this panel is locked, click the lock and provide credentials to unlock it.
- 5. Click Enter Serial Number to display the Activate Serial Number dialog.

- 6. (Optional) In the Name field, enter your name as it is printed in the order confirmation email.
- 7. In the Serial number field, enter the serial number from the order confirmation email. (There are no alphabetic O's in the serial number. The serial number only contains numeric zeroes.)
- 8. Click Activate.

If your Macintosh is on the Internet, the serial number is validated and the software is activated. When you license Flip4Mac Infinity, you can import and export without file size or duration limits.

You should print the receipt before closing the wizard. You will also receive an order confirmation via email that contains the serial number. Save the receipt in case you ever need to re-install the software.



Importing Media into Final Cut Pro

Flip4Mac Infinity allows you to import DV and HDV MXF files directly into Final Cut Pro as QuickTime movies. With Flip4Mac Infinity installed, two new menu items are added to the Import menu:

- Grass Valley Infinity (Local MXF Files)
- Grass Valley Infinity

Click Import > Grass Valley Infinity (Local MXF Files) or Grass Valley Infinity to locate and import MXF files.

Here's how to import files from your Macintosh, SAN or LAN server (detail on Page 9):

- 1. Select File > Import > Grass Valley Infinity (Local Files)
- 2. Browse and check the MXF files you want to import
- 3. Import them into Final Cut Pro as QuickTime movies.

Here's how to import files directly from a REV PRO drive (details on Page 7):

- 1. Select File > Import > Grass Valley Infinity
- 2. Optionally, scan, and then select and connect to the REV PRO drive
- 3. Browse and select the MXF files you want to import
- 4. Import them into Final Cut Pro as QuickTime movies.

After you connect, the process of importing MXF files is the same as importing MXF files from a computer.

Importing Infinity MXF Files from Macintosh, SAN/LAN Servers

You can use this method to import Infinity-sourced MXF files that are stored directly on your computer, SAN or other LAN server. (You can also use this method to import files from mounted REV PRO drives, but it is not as convenient as using Import > Grass Valley Infinity.)

To use this method, follow these steps:

1. File > Import > Grass Valley Infinity (Local MXF Files). Select File > Import > Grass Valley Infinity (Local MXF Files) to display the Select MXF Files dialog.

- Browse and Select Files to Import. Browse to your computer or server, and identify the Infinity ICF folder (multiple selections are allowed) that contains the MXF file to import. Select the folders you want to import files from, and click Select.
- 3. Flip4Mac Infinity displays the Flip4Mac Infinity Import dialog:

Select to view proxy. Check one or more files When checked, the file name displays in the Original column. to import (all checked by default). You can double-click in Import As to edit its destination name.

- 4. **Check Files to Import**. By default, all files you selected are displayed and checked. When a file on the Infinity is checked, you can double-click in the Import as column to change the import name
- 5. **Choose a Destination**. Click Set and select the folder for the imported files. You can save the files directly on your hard drive, or you can save them to another computer or server on the LAN.
- 6. Import Files as QuickTime Movies. To import and convert the selected files, click Import.

Flip4Mac Infinity copies each selected file, automatically converts it to a QuickTime movie (.mov) file, and saves the files in the destination folder. If a timecode is present in the MXF file, it is transferred unchanged to the QuickTime movie file. During conversion, Flip4Mac Infinity displays a progress dialog. As each file completes, it is added to the Final Cut Pro bin.

Note: Movies with the.mxf suffix may be encoded in DV or IMX format.

In trial mode, Flip4Mac Infinity imports the first half of an MXF file, up to 30 seconds in length.

Importing Files from Infinity REV PRO Drives

When you have connected a REV PRO drive to your Macintosh via USB or Firewire, you can import the MXF files that are stored on the mounted disk. This method is preferred when you have several locations (including one or more USB or FireWire-connected Infinity devices) and want to select one of them from a list.

To import files directly from a REV PRO drive using this method, follow these steps:

1. File > Import > Infinity. Select File > Import > Infinity to display the Flip4Mac Infinity connect dialog.

- 2. Scan and Select. Click Scan to update the list and select the inserted disk, or by manually typing the name.
- 3. Connect to the Infinity. To connect to the disk you've selected, click Select.

When you connect, the files on the disk display in the list. A preview panel displays on the right.

- 4. Check Files to Import. When a file on the disk is checked, you can double-click in the Import as column to change the import name.
- 5. **Choose a Destination**. Click Destination and select the folder for the imported files. You can save the files directly on your hard drive, or you can save them to another computer or server on the LAN.
- 6. Import Files as QuickTime Movies. To import and convert the checked files, click Import.

Flip4Mac Infinity copies each checked file, automatically converts it to a QuickTime movie (.mov) file, and saves the files in the destination folder. If a timecode is present in the MXF file, it is transferred unchanged to

the QuickTime movie file. During conversion, Flip4Mac Infinity displays a progress dialog. As each file completes, it is added to the Final Cut Pro bin.

Note: Movies with the mxf suffix may be encoded in HDV, DV or IMX format.

In trial mode, Flip4Mac Infinity imports the first half of an MXF file, up to 30 seconds in length.

File Naming Options

When you are importing several clips, you can rename them as they are imported. Control-click in the Import dialog's file list to choose file naming options.

Check All / Uncheck All. Select to check or uncheck all files in this folder.

Import All > Number Sequentially. Check the first clip you want to import and change its Import name. Then, check the other clips to import. Control-click on the clip whose name you've changed (or any checked clip if unchanged) and select Number Sequentially to automatically modify the Import names of all checked clips, plus a unique numeric suffix beginning at 1 and incrementing by one for each checked clip.

Uninstalling Flip4Mac Infinity

To uninstall Flip4Mac Infinity, quit Final Cut Pro and any other QuickTime applications.

Open the Library > QuickTime folder and drag the Flip4Mac Infinity.component file to the Trash.

Open the Library > PreferencePanes folder and drag the Flip4Mac Infinity.prefPane file to the Trash.

Open the Library > Application Support > Final Cut Pro System Support > Plug-ins folder and drag the Flip4Mac Infinity PlugIn.bundle to the Trash.

The serial number remains on your Macintosh, for use if you re-install the software.
