



Release Notes

ATTENTION all previous version customers!

Version 10 is a paid upgrade and requires a new serial number. If you are upgrading from versions 4-9, users will retain the same serial number when upgrading to version 10. Versions 1, 2, and 3 are not eligible for upgrade pricing.

If you install version 10 and attempt to complete a project without purchasing a new license or upgrade, your videos exported from ScreenFlow 10 will contain a watermark. Once you have entered a valid version 10 serial, projects that were created in demo mode can be re-exported to remove the watermark.

To obtain the upgrade pricing:

- Versions 6+:
 - Install ScreenFlow 10 and use a buy link in the ScreenFlow menu or Preferences>License panel.
 - Your prior version serial number must be activated in the ScreenFlow Preferences> License panel of ScreenFlow 10 before initiating the upgrade process.
 - Unable to launch a prior version or having other upgrade issues? Use our [Web Upgrade Tool](#).
- Versions 4 and 5:
 - You **must** use our [Web Up grade Tool](#).
 - Alternatively, you can contact our sales team for assistance, though the Web Upgrade tool is strongly recommended for the quickest experience.
- Versions 1, 2, and 3:
 - Not eligible for upgrade pricing.
 - You must purchase ScreenFlow 10 at its retail price.

Mac App Store Customers:

Unfortunately, the Mac App Store does not allow for product upgrades. If you missed the launch day pricing, you have two options:

1. You can purchase ScreenFlow 10 from the Mac App Store at full price. This option would allow you to run ScreenFlow on as many devices as the Mac App Store allows.
2. You may use our [Web Upgrade Tool](#) to obtain upgrade pricing. This will require that you transfer your license to a Telestream license, upgrade to ScreenFlow 10, and run it on one device at a time per the Telestream EULA.

What's New:

- **New Screen Recording capabilities (SF-73)**
 - Add ability to exclude ScreenFlow from recordings.
 - Can exclude Recording Monitor from recording
 - Add ability to exclude specific applications from recordings.
 - Add ability to include only specific applications in recordings.
 - Add ability to record screen regions.
 - Add support for looped and timed recordings.
- **Add native system audio recording using Basic Computer Audio**
 - No audio driver installation is needed.
 - Ability to record each application's audio separately.
- **Recording Monitor improvements**
 - Display desktop preview from recorder (SF-108)
 - Display audio levels from microphones (SF-109)
 - Display audio levels received from recorder (SF-110)

Fixes:

- **SF-274:** Fixed SRT files with malformed timecode separators show blank captions when imported.
- **SF-270:** Fixed some transitions apply to the entire canvas instead of the selected clip.
- **SF-262:** Fixed some help links throughout the app.
- **SF-253:** Fixed audio from disabled channel 1 plays back after reopening project.
