



## ScreenFlow 4.5 Release Notes

### **ATTENTION Version 3.x, 2.x and Version 1.x Customers**

Version 4.x is a \$29 paid upgrade from previous versions of ScreenFlow, and will require a new serial number. In order to get the \$29 upgrade price, your current serial number must be activated in the Preferences> License panel. If you install version 4 without purchasing a new serial number, your videos exported from ScreenFlow 4 will contain a watermark. [Please read these upgrade instructions before installing.](#)

### **ATTENTION Version 4.x customers**

Version 4.5 is a free update and will not require a purchase

## **System Requirements**

- Mac OS X Lion 10.7 and higher, including Mavericks  
Intel\* based CPU required. Core 2 Duo recommended
- A supported programmable GPU required for certain effects & functionality
- Cameras using the HDV codec are not supported

\*Intel GMA chips are unable to support Motion Blur and some Callout features

- Expanded Publishing support – now includes options to publish to Google Drive, Dropbox and Facebook
- Improved Upload Manager now allows for asynchronous uploads in the background to free up timeline
- New Wipe Transition Pack available for purchase (\$19.99)
- Improved ability to manage transitions and mark ones as favorites
- Added search field to Video & Audio filter popover
- Implemented double-clicking sending source to timeline when in the media library list mode
- Added 60 fps option to the Pro-Res export and 25 fps to H.264 options to standardize
- Added 'Select All' when the media library is in thumbnail mode
- Added Shift as a modifier for multiple selection in the canvas
- Implemented 'Deselect All' for the Media Library
- Fixed bug where edits were getting lost on 10.9

- Fixed transition color well to be correctly selectable

- Fixed issue where splitting a nested clip containing child transitions removed them

- Flipped the main audio meters to have left on the top, right on the bottom

- Audio transitions now only have a cross dissolve

- Now perform parametric conversion of colors to screen, default to sRGB when incoming image content is untagged, and add transmission of color space from QuickTime XPC service for more accurate color conversion
- Fixed brightness not snapping to 100% easily
- ScreenFlow now forces the width/height of a camera if no frames are received increasing compatibility with USB devices

- Fixed hour number not highlighting in the timecode view when there is an hour's worth of content
- Prevented crash when opening 3.x document with DV footage

- Fixed incorrect limits to blur and feather sliders on Callout Properties
- Ignore the freehand content when setting a callout's defaults

- Added a scale cap to the export dimensions
- Fixed being unable to create an audio only export using Web High preset
- Fixed issue that caused media to move when canvas was cropped in nested clip
- Fixed issue causing 'Make Settings Default' to not work across multiple documents
- Fixed issue that in certain circumstance caused the inability to record using the MAS version
- Made the tab key move in/out of the description field in the Vimeo metadata view
- Allowed modifier-only keys to be shown on screen
