

Vantage 8.3 Qualify 2025.10 Release Notes

About This Release

This is a ComponentPac release for Vantage that includes new features, improvements, and bug fixes for the Qualify action.

These release notes are applicable to the Qualify option for Vantage. Refer to separate Version 8.3 release notes for Vantage Platform and other components of Vantage for additional information.

Note: This release is intended for Vantage 8.3

New Features

Ticket	Description
VN-768	<p>Added a secondary optional input to the Qualify action for Caption Sync:</p> <p>The new Caption Sync feature for Qualify requires two input files: 1) a media file and 2) a sidecar captions file. The Qualify action now supports an optional secondary input nickname to enable this functionality.</p> <p>Since the secondary input is for sidecar files, it allows both media or attachment nicknames to be used.</p>

Improvements

Ticket	Description
VN-883	Removed Pause/Resume support from the Qualify action. The Qualify action no longer responds to pause requests, as this operation is not applicable to the Qualify workflow.
VN-920	Qualify Professional license is now enforced when using the new "ai_language_detection" schema. Vantage now correctly requires a Qualify Professional license when AI Audio Language Detection is enabled in Qualify templates.
VN-926	Removed "Errored" from the Job Status variable tooltip for newly created Qualify actions. The Errored status was listed but was not a possible output state for the Qualify action.

Prerequisites

Verify that the Vantage domain has been upgraded to 8.3 per the instructions above. The Qualify Service can be installed on any server that is currently running a valid installation of Vantage 8.3.

1. Install the Qualify service patch on the machine—open the Vantage 8.3 folder and double-click *Vantage_8_3_Qualify_Service_Patch_Setup(8.3.58.6).exe*. Agree to the license terms and click Install.

When you have successfully installed the Qualify Service, you may add it to the Vantage domain using the Vantage Management Console.

2. Start the Vantage Management Console and select the Add Services to Vantage Domain option. When the Qualify service is found, select it to add it to the domain.

Note: For more information on adding services to a Vantage domain, please refer to the Vantage Domain Management Guide.

3. In the Vantage Management Console go to the ComponentPac section and select Install New Packages. In the window that pops-up, select the Qualify 2025.10 ComponentPac and click Install.

Note: If the Qualify ComponentPac does not show up and is not already installed, please verify that the ComponentPac file is in the proper location. Refer to the Vantage Domain Management Guide for details on managing ComponentPacs in Vantage.

The Qualify for Vantage Service is now ready to use.

Known Issue: AI Language Detection test fails when using "treat_warnings_as": 3 ("Same As Parent"). This combination causes Qualify jobs to fail with a PDF report generation error.

Workaround: Use "treat_warnings_as" values 0 (Info), 1 (Warning), or 2 (Error) instead. This issue is specific to AI Language Detection and does not affect other Qualify QC tests.
