Installation

To install FlipFactory within a ProEncode environment, follow these steps:

- 1. Install the Avid software by following the instructions provided by Avid.
- Install DMS Broker software
- Install ProEncode Provider software on same server where FlipFactory is installed.
- Configure the DMS Broker and Register the ProEncode Provider with the Broker.
- Install and configure FlipFactory on same system as ProEncode Provider (see Chapter 2 of FlipFactory Users Guide for installation instructions).
- The FlipFactory installer will automatically copy the proencode.jar file from the FlipFactory folder to the ProEncode Provider folder

Note: If you have FlipFactory 7.0 or greater that was **not** an update from and earlier version, you will need to also place a copy of dom4j-1.6.1.jar into the ProEncode Provider folder. To obtain a copy of the dom4j-1.6.1.jar file, contact your Telestream support representative.

- Create a FlipFactory account named proencode by following the instructions within the FlipFactory Users Guide Chapter 5 - Administer Accounts
- Create the appropriate factories by following the instructions within the FlipFactory Users
 Guide Chapter 6 (Note: a Destination for the Flipped media can be set at the time of
 submission. Additional destinations can be defined within a Factory but are not required

Note: Due to conflicts with Java runtime versions the FlipFactory client application cannot be opened on the ProEncode server. To open the FlipFactory client application simple enter the following URL from any PC on the network: http://<ip address of the FlipFactory server>:9000.

- 3. To configure the ProEncode Provider for FlipFactory enter the following parameters:
- Provider Name: Type the Provider Name that you supplied when you registered the Provider.
 If you need to change the Provider Name, you can type the new name here, but you also need to change it and reregister the Provider.
- Media Services Engine Hostname: Type the Host Name as needed.
- **Automatically Connect**: Select Yes to connect to the Broker whenever the Provider software is started. If you select No, you need to connect the Provider before you can use ProEncode.
- Settings Directory: Location of FlipFactory control entry program.
 Enter < FlipFactory IP Address >:1099
- Account Name: By default, the name is filled in as proencode. This requires that the FlipFactory Account proencode be established by the User.

- 4. To install the ProEncode client on edit workstation, from the Avid workstation open Internet Explorer and type in the URL: http://<server name>:8080/ProEncodeApplet.html
- 5. Configure the ProEncode client (follow the instructions provided by Avid)
- 6. Send jobs to FlipFactory via ProEncode
