



Getting Started with Episode

The easy-to-use intuitive dragand-drop graphical user interface and workflow builder simplifies the encoding process.

1 Install

- a. Double-click the installer (PC) or double-click the .pkg file (Mac).
- b. Follow step-by-step instructions to install. Once you have installed, read the License Agreement and click "Accept" to continue.
- c. Double-click to open app. Enter your license number by choosing Episode > Preferences.... (Mac) or Episode > Edit preferences (PC) and selecting the license tab.
- d. After entering your serial number, click "Activate" to upgrade your product from demo mode.

2 Encode using a default workflow

- a. The quickest way to get started is by using one of the pre-built workflows that can be found in the workflows tab.
- b. Choose a category from the drop down list, and drag one of the pre-built workflows to the workflow editor below.
- c. The pre-built workflows are predefined with an encoder and the deployment destination is set to "same as source".
- d. Add media files from the Episode media browser or drag and drop from the finder/explorer.
- e. Next, re-name the workflow and pick a priority (optional), and hit Submit.
- f. You will see the new workflow appear in the status window at the bottom, where you can monitor the progress of the job.
- g. The encoded file is delivered to the defined destination as your source file, where you can view the encoded result.
